

Computer Literacy for Teachers

Goals:

- Imparting computer literacy to students of government schools in Daman.
- Using technically advanced tools for class room teaching to increase effectiveness of the various educational modules.
- To provide basic computer knowledge to the primary school teachers, enabling them to utilize the already existing computer systems for daily use.



Location : Daman

Brief of the activity : All the primary schools in Daman have computers. Due to the absence of computer literacy, these computers are not being used either by teachers nor the students. By providing them the basic knowledge on how to operate the computer systems, the same knowledge then be used to provide computer training to the students of these schools, and make better use of the systems already made available by the government. 28 primary school teachers have been given basic computer knowledge in two batches in the first phase of the project.

Progress : The project is providing the teachers' basic computer operating knowledge, which will be used and further taught to the students. The first sections of teachers have already been provided this training

Benefits : Teachers in turn will provide basic computer knowledge to the students.
Computers will be used by teachers for maintaining office records immediately after the training.
