**Brief of the activity** : The project aims at providing employment opportunities to rural women through planned activities like manufacturing of leather goods and stationery items. It also aims at improving the agricultural practices in the region. These opportunities will not only help rural women develop a sustainable livelihood but also empower them to actively take part in village development. Suzlon Foundation has formed women Self-Help Groups (SHG) on the basis of activity, kinship, interest, and resource usage. The foundation has also taken up the responsibility of nurturing and supporting these groups to assist them over a period of time.

**Progress** : More than 15 Self Help Groups have been formed working on different interests and activities.

**Benefits** : Currently the project is focusing on empowerment of rural women towards village development activities.
